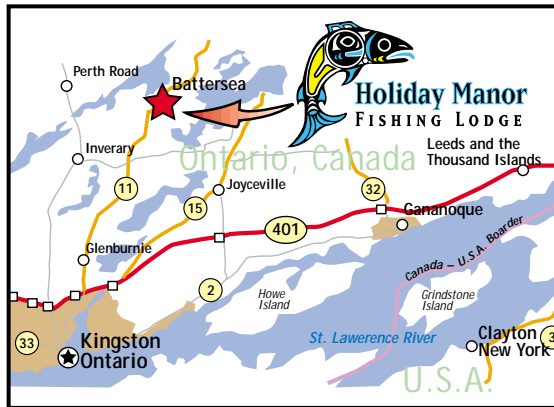

## History

Originally a family home and farm house, this 10,000 square ft stone Manor overlooks the river entry into Battersea Bay on Loughborough lake. The building rises from an outcropping of million year old Canadian Shield bedrock to the right of the road as you first enter the Village of Battersea. The Resort Marina sits to the left of the road at either end of the Bridge.

Built in 1840, by Henry Van Luven, a veteran of the Battle of Lundy's Lane, and the founder of the village of Battersea, Ontario near the Rideau Canal.

Henry was elected in 1850 as the first reeve of Storrington Township. He also built the stone mill in Battersea which was later owned and operated by the Anglin family. In the ensuing years he was instrumental in founding a variety of community institutions including the school and church. The large Van Luven family home was converted in 1912 to an upscale fishing lodge, first called the Van Luven House, today it is the Holiday Manor.

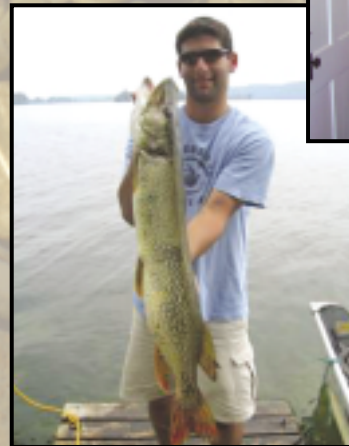


## Canada's Fishing Spot

Loughborough Lake is the southernmost trout lake in Canada. Less than a mile away is Dog Lake and the Rideau Canal system.

You will find large and small mouth bass, northern pike and a variety of pan fish. The deeper, reservoir like portion of the lake, contains large mouth and small mouth bass, northern pike, lake and rainbow trout and pan fish.
